Moolaham Foundation is a Digital Archive and a Digital Library undertaking the critical work of documenting, digitally preserving and providing free and open access to knowledge bases and cultural heritage of Sri Lankan Tamil speaking communities. We are a non-profit, charitable organization (GA 2390) based in Sri Lanka. It was initiated in 2005 as a digital library project named Project Noolaham, which emphasized volunteerism openness. In 2008, pioneers of Project Noolaham in consultation with all the stakeholders decided to incorporate the activities to sustain the digital archiving initiatives in Sri 2010, Noolaham Lanka. In Foundation formally was incorporated as а guaranteed company.

#### **MISSION**

Noolaham Foundation's mission is to document & preserve knowledge, properties & values of all spheres related to the Sri Lankan Tamil Speaking communities, make such knowledge accessible to all & capacities communities to engage in knowledge building and learning.
