They will supervise the system and quality assurance processes as the fast-evolving digital documentation, preservation and archiving technologies are at the heart of our mission. This position is also responsible for developing, maintaining and supporting our core software and hardware systems. The candidate will work with Technology Sector members, expert resources, staff and volunteers to build a strong technical infrastructure required to support Noolaham Foundation's mission.

The Technology sector lead will work with and build cutting edge software systems. Ample formal and non-formal opportunities will be provided to grow your technical and management skill set. Compensation will be based on skill set and performance.
